ON THE ROAD

Traveling from one place to another is another great opportunity to discover shapes, letters, colors and numbers on the many signs we see along the road.

Colors and Shapes

Help your child find shapes and colors on signs you see on the road. Give your child a picture of a circle on one trip and see how many you can find along the way. Next time, give them a triangle and a square the next time. Every trip you can focus on a different shape!

Familiar Locations

As you pass places, your child will recognize ask your child to tell you about the letters they know. You can also give your child a copy of his/her name and let them circle each letter in their name as they see it on different signs!

How Many Wheels?

Help your child identify how many wheels they see on different vehicles. If they see a bicycle or motorcycle they can count two wheels. If they see a car they can count four wheels. If they see a fire truck or big truck they can count more wheels! Two! Four! More!

Counting Signs

Ask your child how many signs can you count on your street? Can your child “read” any of them? Do they recognize a stop sign, a school sign or a street sign? What kinds of signs can you find and what do they mean?
