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Session 9 Portion Control / Letters & Counting

LAUNDRY LEARNING!

Make washday a learning experience! You can have loads of fun as you do loads of wash!

Try these activities:

Washing Engineer: When it's time to wash the clothes, invite your child to help you by separating the colors, loading the washer and measuring the detergent.

Colors & Laundry: Ask your child to identify the colors in the laundry. Put the different colors into piles. Which color has the biggest pile? And which color has the smallest pile? How many different blues do you see? How many different greens?

Laundry Letters: Encourage your child to find letters on the detergent box. After the box is empty, cut out the letters and let the children play with them.

Folding and Hanging: When it's time to fold or hang the dry clothes, ask your child to help you match the socks, towels and clothing items.

Special Delivery: Ask your child to tell you which rooms the different clothes go to around the house. Where do the towels go? Which room got the most laundry delivered? Which one got the least?

Remember, every room can be a learning place!
